THE GATHERING OF THE COMMUNITY

The people, as able, gather in the parish garden for a traditional smudging ceremony. Following this, The Bishop may further acknowledge the traditional territory on which we gather.

with you all.

People: **And also with you.**

All together, as able, process to the front doors the church building on Pearl Street. The doors are opened, and the Bishop leads in prayer:

Bishop: The Lord be with you.
People: **And also with you.**

Bishop: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
People: **It is right to give our thanks and praise.**

Bishop: Blessed are you, saving God, for you guide our
footsteps and illumine our path.
You bless our coming in and our going out;
from birth to death, you hold us in your care.
People: **Blessed be God for ever and ever.**

Bishop: Bless these doors, O God, consecrated to your glory.
Whenever we enter here, draw us ever more deeply
into your Presence so we may celebrate the wonders
of your love.
Whenever we depart from here, draw us ever more
deeply into your Presence so we may see your face in
the sick, the hungry, and all in need.
May these doors be open to all people,
and serve as a sign of the welcoming love
you extend at your gathering table in the church and
in the world.
People: **Blessed be God for ever and ever.**

Everyone, as able, enters the Church Proper as the Entrance Hymn is sung.
