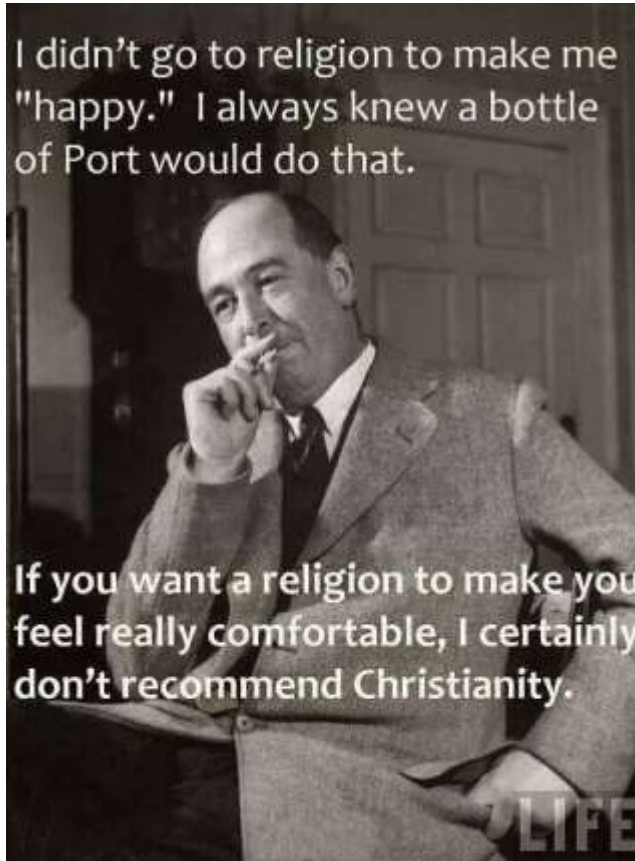

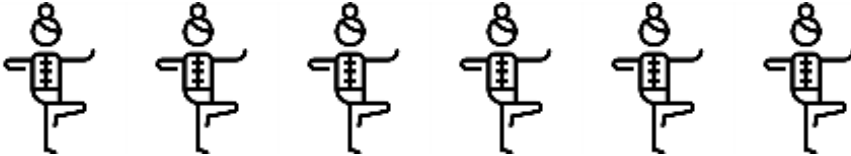

## **Yemen Emergency Response**

Gathering Table's Food Cupboard is mandated to provide two days food supplies to its clients. With assistance from RFDA, Lutheran churches, and our parish's support this goal can be met. You can support the Cupboard in the following ways.

Canned vegetables (peas, green/yellow beans, cream or kernel corn, and carrots), Soup (mushroom, vegetable, chicken noodle, and tomato), Canned meat (Holiday, Klilk, flakes of ham, chicken, turkey, tuna, and salmon), Mac and Cheese KD, Canned meals (Pork & Beans, Stews, and Chef Boyardee)
